A cookie is a small data text file which is placed on your hard disk by a web page server. We use cookies on our website. Insofar as these cookies are not strictly necessary for the provision of our website we will ask you to consent to our use of cookies when you first visit our website.

There are only two cookies on our website.

The first is a Preference cookie, which enable a website to remember information that changes the way the website behaves or looks, like your preferred language or the region that you are in. This cookie's purpose description: Remembers the user's submitted data when a comment is submitted in a blog post. The purpose is to auto-populate form fields for subsequent comments, in order to save time for the user. However, comments are disabled on our website, so this cookie will not affect you.

The second is a Marketing cookie, which are used to track visitors across websites. The intention is to display ads that are relevant and engaging for the individual user and thereby more valuable for publishers and third party advertisers. This cookie's purpose description: Registers a unique ID that identifies a returning user's device. The ID is used for targeted ads. This cookie is part of the Google map embedded in the site.
